REGISTRATION:

- Registration for all SD83 StrongStart programs is ongoing throughout the year
- If your child was previously registered in a StrongStart program in our district, please call the school to indicate that you and your child are interested in attending the StrongStart program again this school year
- If your child is new to StrongStart, please phone the school to request a time to come in and complete the registration process
- Interested families will need to **choose one program to attend** as we will not be supporting participation at multiple programs due to COVID-19, at this time

SD83 STRONGSTART PROGRAM COVID-19 GUIDELINES:

- Families will be required to stay at home when sick
- SD83 is a “mask friendly” environment and medical grade masks will be available for those choosing to wear one
- All participants will be required to follow safe hand hygiene practices: sanitizing/washing hands before and after eating, after using the washroom, etc.
- Adults and children are encouraged to respect other people’s personal space
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfecting protocols will be in place
- All programs will follow the current public health guidelines as outlined in the [Public Health Communicable Disease Guidance for K-12 Schools](#)
- All programs will be open on their regular days, but for shorter periods of time (2.5 hours per day) to allow for the enhanced cleaning protocols, contact with families, and attendance scheduling
- Only 10 families may attend a program at one time (a family unit includes members of the same family plus up to 2 children from another family, ages 0 to 5)
- All families must be registered prior to attending the program
- Once families have registered for the program, they will be contacted by the StrongStart Educator to discuss scheduling options for attendance
- Snacks for children will be provided in individual portions and served by the StrongStart Educator
- Coffee/tea will be provided for adults; please bring a reusable cup with a lid
- Outside play and learning time will be encouraged as much as possible

We understand that StrongStart programs look a bit different due to COVID-19, but we are doing our best to provide quality early learning programming for families, while ensuring that everyone is safe.
